

A. 2-Team Tiebreaker Rules (Two teams tied for one playoff spot)

1. **Head to Head competition, if applicable**
2. **Point Differential (Total Points Scored, minus Total Points Allowed)**
3. **Total Points scored**
4. **Free Throws (attempt 3 per team)**

- **Head to Head competition tiebreaker Example:**

- If Team A and Team B have identical records after completing their regular schedules, and;
- Team A defeated Team B in their meeting, then;
- Team A wins the tiebreaker and the playoff spot

- **Point Differential tiebreaker Example:**

- If Team A and Team B have identical records after completing their regular schedules, and;
- Team A and Team B did not compete in Head to Head competition
- Team A has point differential of +3 (scores of: 16-11, 14-12, 14-16, 10-13)
- Team B has point differential of -1 (scores of: 16-14, 14-10, 11-16, 10-12)
- Team A wins the tiebreaker and the playoff spot

- **Total Points scored Example:**

- If Team A and Team B have identical records after completing their regular schedules, and;
- Team A and Team B did not compete in Head to Head competition and their Point Differential was identical, and;
- Team A has Point Differential of +4 and Total Points scored of 56 (scores of: 16-11, 16-13, 14-16, 10-13)
- Team B has Point Differential of +4 and Total Points scored of 50 (scores of: 12-8, 14-10, 14-16, 10-12)
- Team A wins the tiebreaker and the playoff spot due to more Points Scored

- **Free Throws Example:**

- If the two teams are still tied after the first 3 tiebreakers, then each team will attempt 3-Free Throws (alternate shots with a different shooter for each shot), team with the most shots made after 3 attempts will win
- If it remains tied, each team will attempt 1-Free Throw (alternate shots with different shooter each time) until a winner is decided, sudden death
 - No one player on a team may shoot an additional Free Throw until all teammates have taken their Free Throw(s)

B. 3-Team Tiebreaker Rules (Three teams tied for one or two playoff spots)

- 1. Head to Head competition, if applicable (all 3 teams played each other)**
- 2. Point Differential (Total Points Scored, minus Total Points Allowed)**
- 3. Total Points scored**
- 4. Free Throws (attempt 3 per team)**

- **Head to Head competition tiebreaker:**
 - If the 3 teams did not all play each, move to Point Differential tiebreaker
 - If the Head to Head comparison creates a 3-way tie, where each team is 1-1 vs the other two teams, move to Point Differential tiebreaker
 - If Team A beat Team B and Team C, Team A wins the tiebreaker and playoff spot. If there is a second playoff spot for Team B & Team C, use Tiebreaker rules for 2-Teams
- **Point Differential tiebreaker:**
 - If all 3 teams have identical Point Differential, move to Total Points scored tiebreaker; else
 - If one playoff spot is being determined:
 - If one team has the best Point Differential, they win the tiebreaker
 - If two teams are tied for best Point Differential, use Tiebreaker rules for 2-Teams, between the two teams with best Point Differential
 - If two playoff spots are being determined:
 - If one team has the best Point Differential, they win one playoff spot
 - The other two teams follow Tiebreaker rules for 2 Teams to determine winner of next playoff spot
 - If two teams tie for the best Point Differential, they both win playoff spots
- **Total Points scored:**
 - If all 3 teams have identical Total Points Score, move to Free Throw competition as tiebreaker; else
 - If one playoff spot is being determined:
 - If one team has the best Total Points Scored, they win the tiebreaker
 - If two teams are tied for best Total Points Scored, use Tiebreaker rules for 2-Teams, between the two teams with best Total Points Scored
 - If two playoff spots are being determined:
 - If one team has the best Total Points Scored, they win one playoff spot
 - The other two teams follow Tiebreaker rules for 2 Teams to determine winner of next playoff spot
 - If two teams tie for the best Point Differential, they both win playoff spots
- **Free Throws:**

- If the three teams are still tied after the first three tiebreakers, then each team will attempt 3-Free Throws (alternate shots, with a different shooter for each shot), team with the most shots made after 3 attempts will win
- If it remains tied, each team will attempt 1-Free Throw (alternate shots, with different shooter each time) until a winner is decided, sudden death
 - No one player on a team may shoot an additional Free Throw until all teammates have taken their Free Throw(s)

C. Forfeited Games

- If a team does not show, the forfeited game will result in a victory for the team that is present and given a score of 2-0, plus the opportunity to score on 5 Free Throws.
 - The team awarded the Forfeit win will be allowed to attempt five Free Throws (No one player may shoot an additional Free Throw until all teammates have taken their Free Throw) and 1 point, for every made basket made, will be added to the final Score (maximum score is 7-0).
 - Forfeited games and scores will be included in Tiebreakers.
